Attendees should have general experience with the Windows operating system. Moderate AudioVAULT experience is recommended.

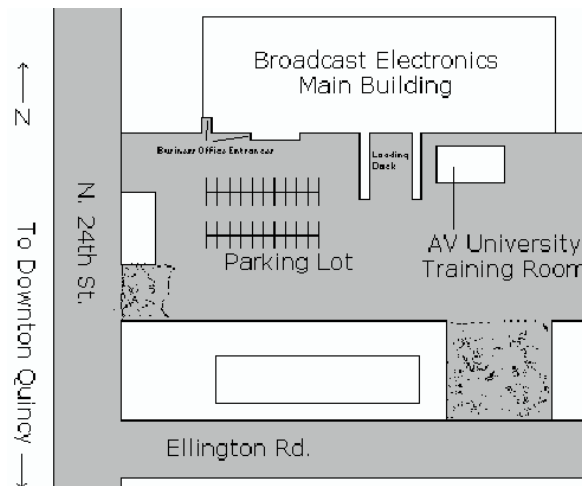
