



CNC Machinist

The CNC machinist operates a computer numerical control machine to produce machined parts and products according to required specifications.

Key Responsibilities

- Regularly performs milling, turning, drilling, grooving, cutting, tapping, de-burring, sawing and sanding tasks; taking measurements; detecting malfunctions; adjust and reprogramming controls; sharpening and replacing worn tools.
- Review specifications on blueprints, bill of materials, and other related documents to determine setup procedure, machining sequence and dimensions.
- Performs inspection of machined products, and documents and communicates actions, irregularities, and continuing needs to management.
- Detects and reports defective materials or questionable conditions to management.
- Maintains the work area and equipment in a clean, orderly condition and follows prescribed safety procedures.
- Adheres to quality assurance procedures and processes.

Education, Experience and Skills

- High School diploma or GED equivalent required.
- Minimum of two years' of related CNC manufacturing experience preferred.
- Extensive knowledge of machine maintenance and operation required.
- Basic math and computing knowledge.
