



SMT Technician

The SMT Technician will program and operate the Surface Mount Technology equipment to build electronic circuit boards to ensure ship dates and quality standards are met.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform programming, troubleshooting, and maintenance of SMT machine.
- Read and interpret schematics and diagrams to construct electronic assemblies.
- Loading and unloading feeders and carriages.
- Hand place or hand solder parts that the SMT equipment cannot pick up.
- Perform first piece inspection and quality verification at each phase of the process.
- Test and troubleshoot electronic assemblies using equipment such as oscilloscopes, multi-meters, and frequency generators.

- Two years of prior electronics assembly experience a plus.
- Strong knowledge of best practices in the electronics assembly environment.
